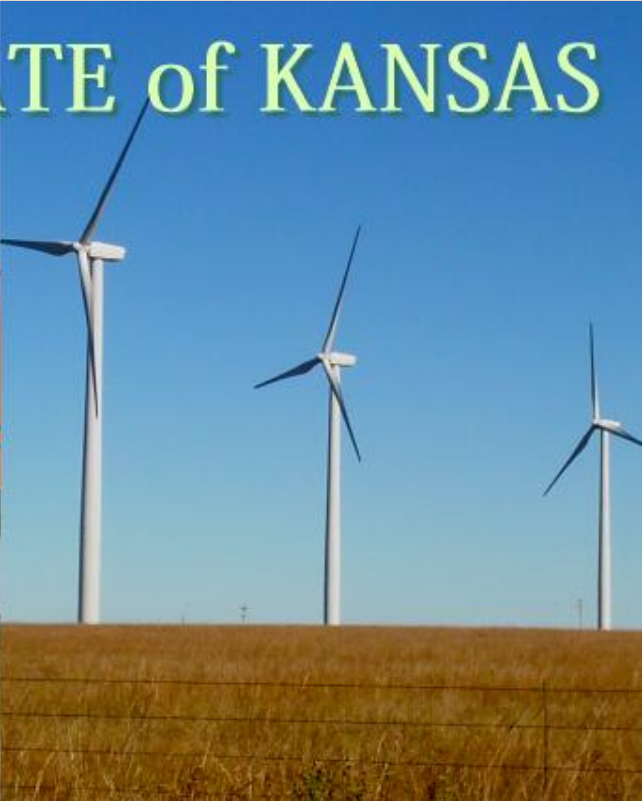


State Perspective 2008

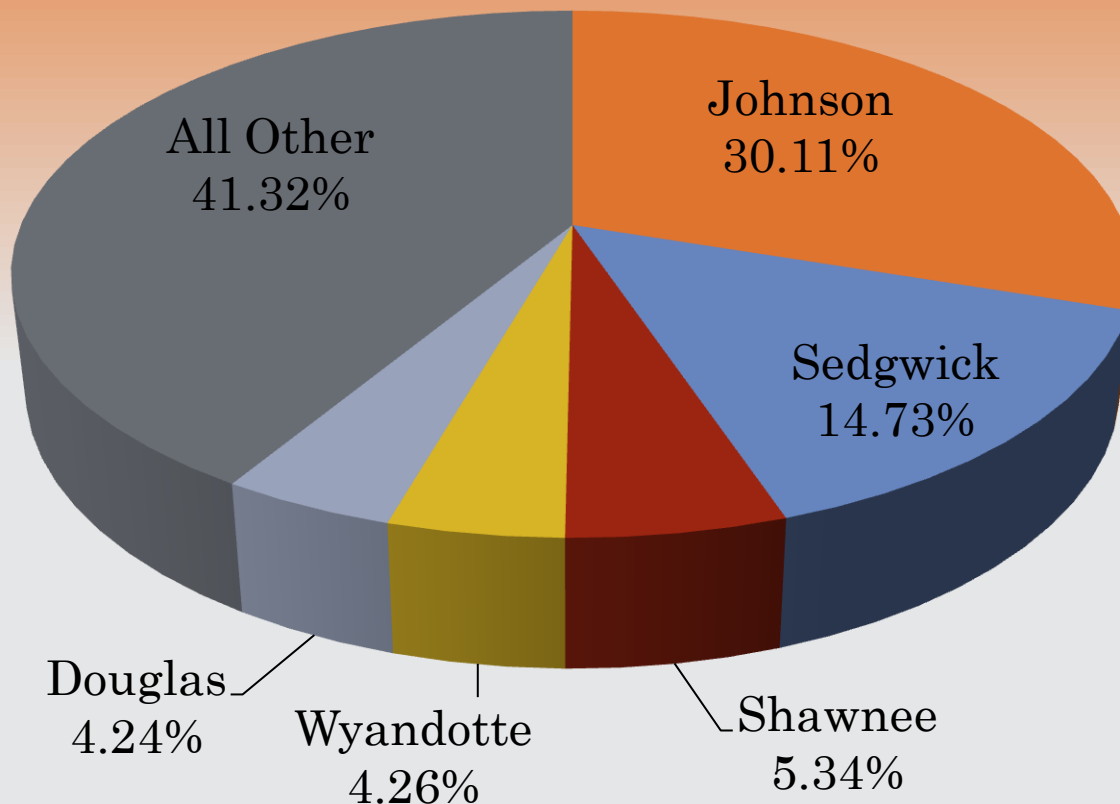

This total includes residential, commercial and personal property values

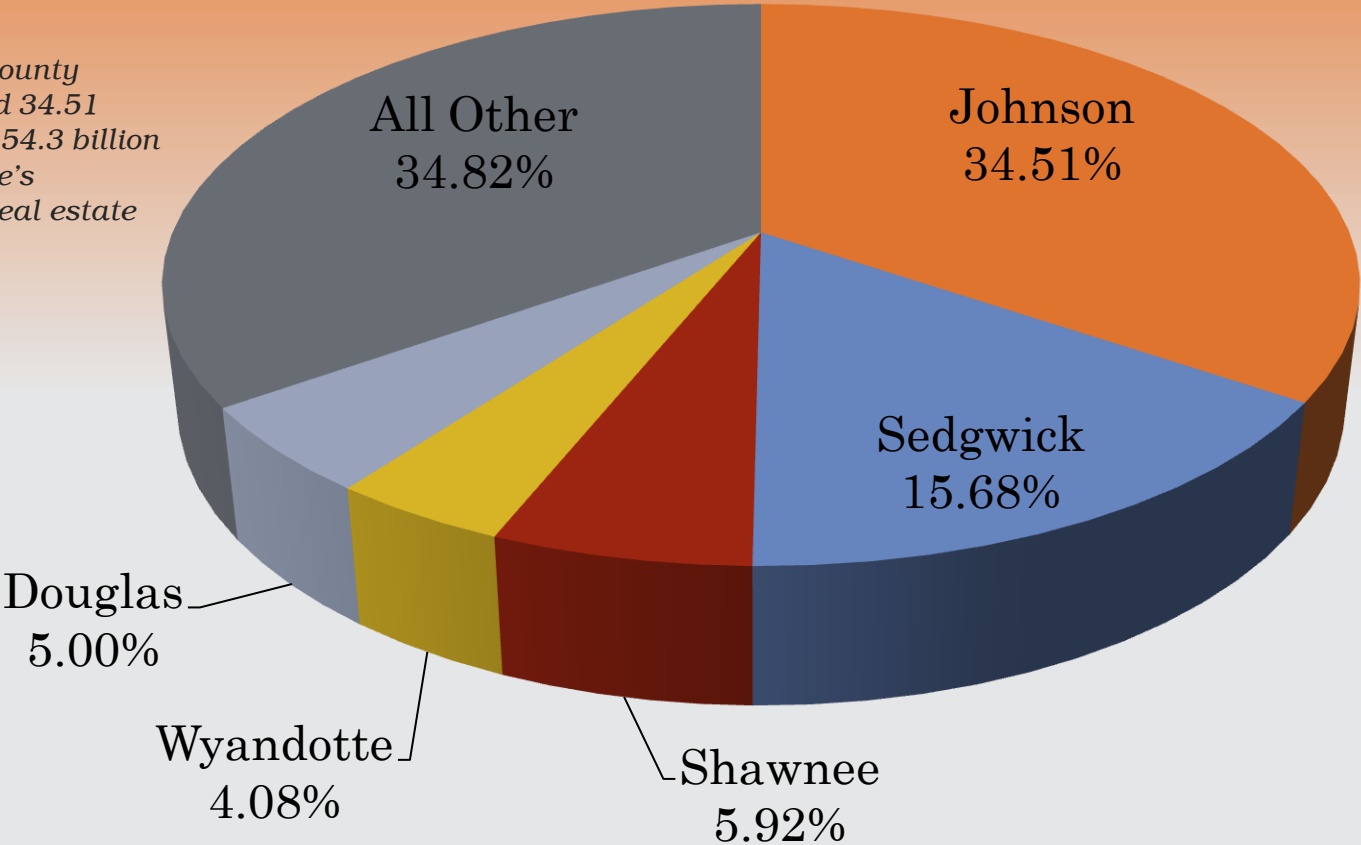

Total Assessed Residential Real Estate

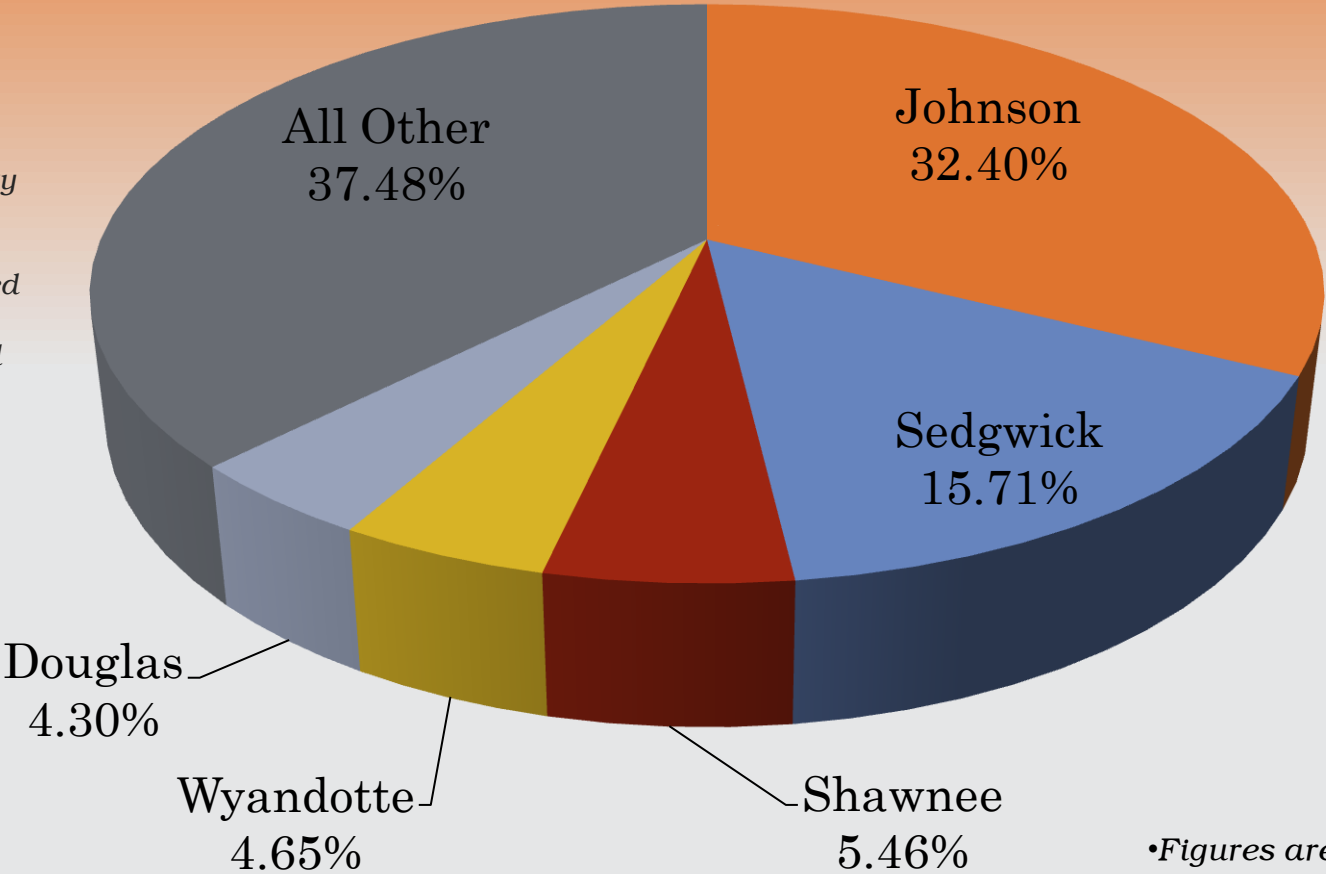
Johnson County contributed 34.51 percent or 54.3 billion of the State's assessed real estate value

Total Assessed Real Estate Property



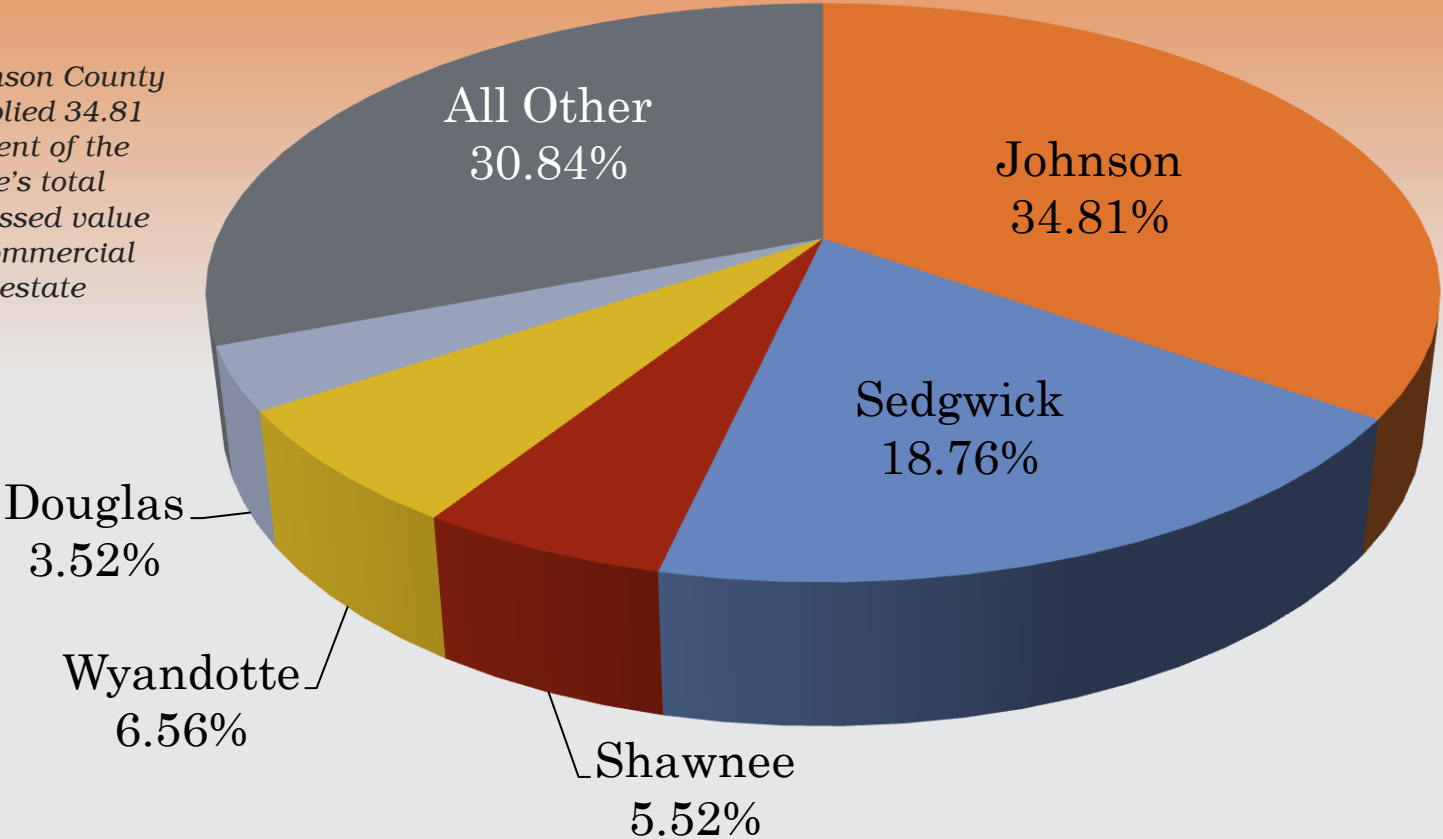
Johnson County supplied 32.40 percent of the State's assessed value in residential real estate

Johnson County supplied 34.81 percent of the State's total assessed value in commercial real estate

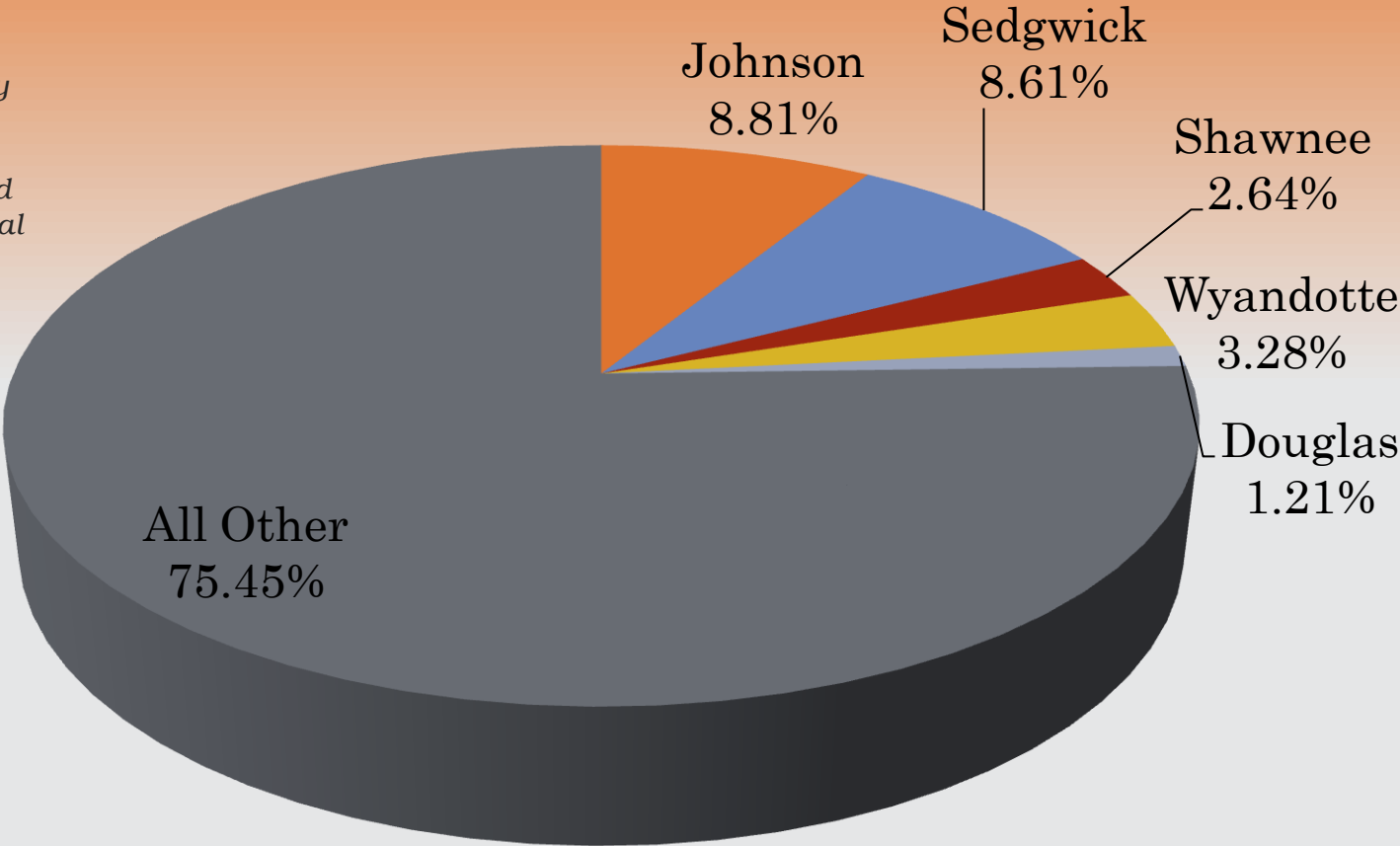

Total Assessed Personal Property

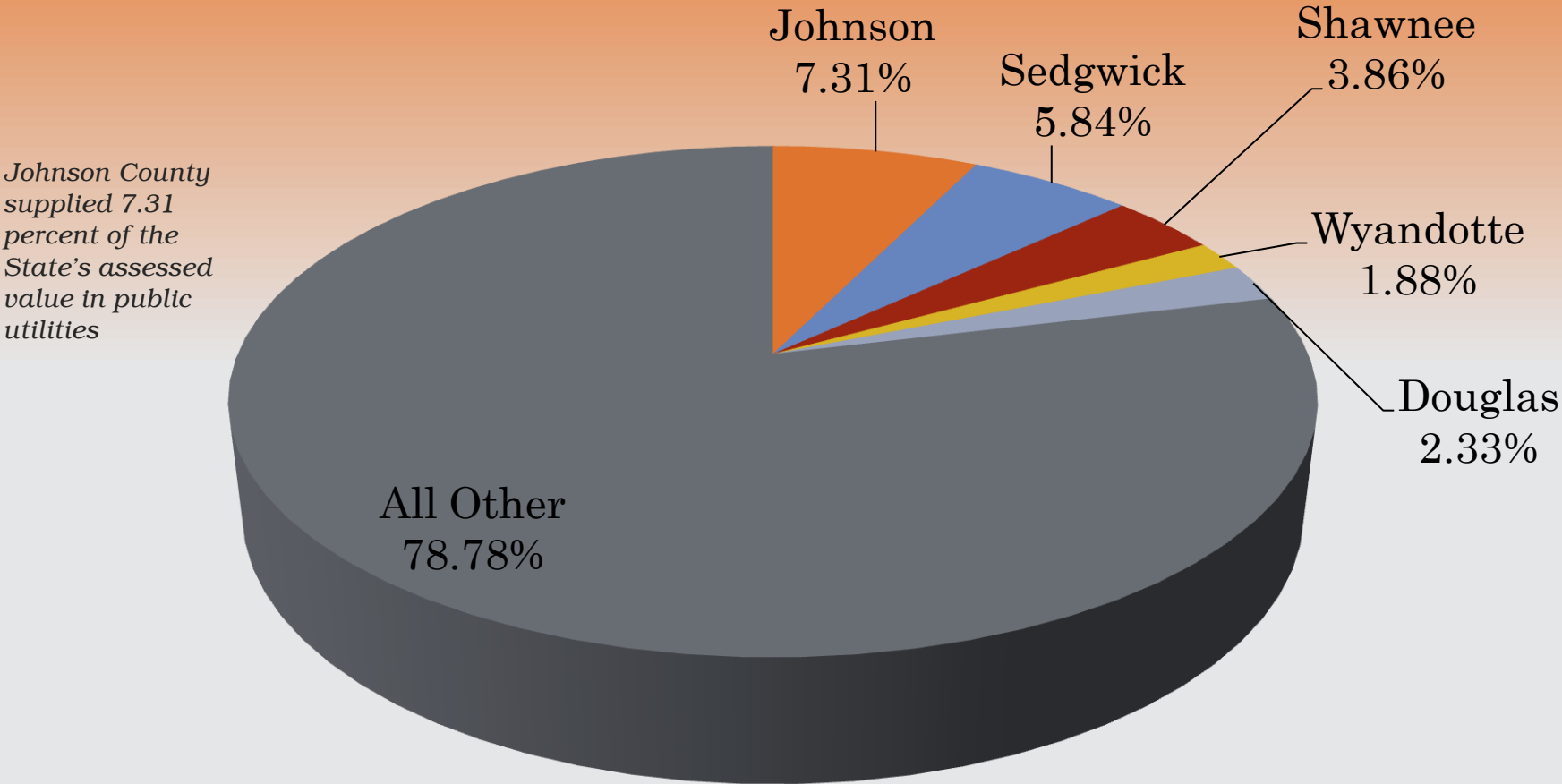
Johnson County supplied 8.81 percent of the State's assessed value in personal property valuation

Total Assessed Public Utilities

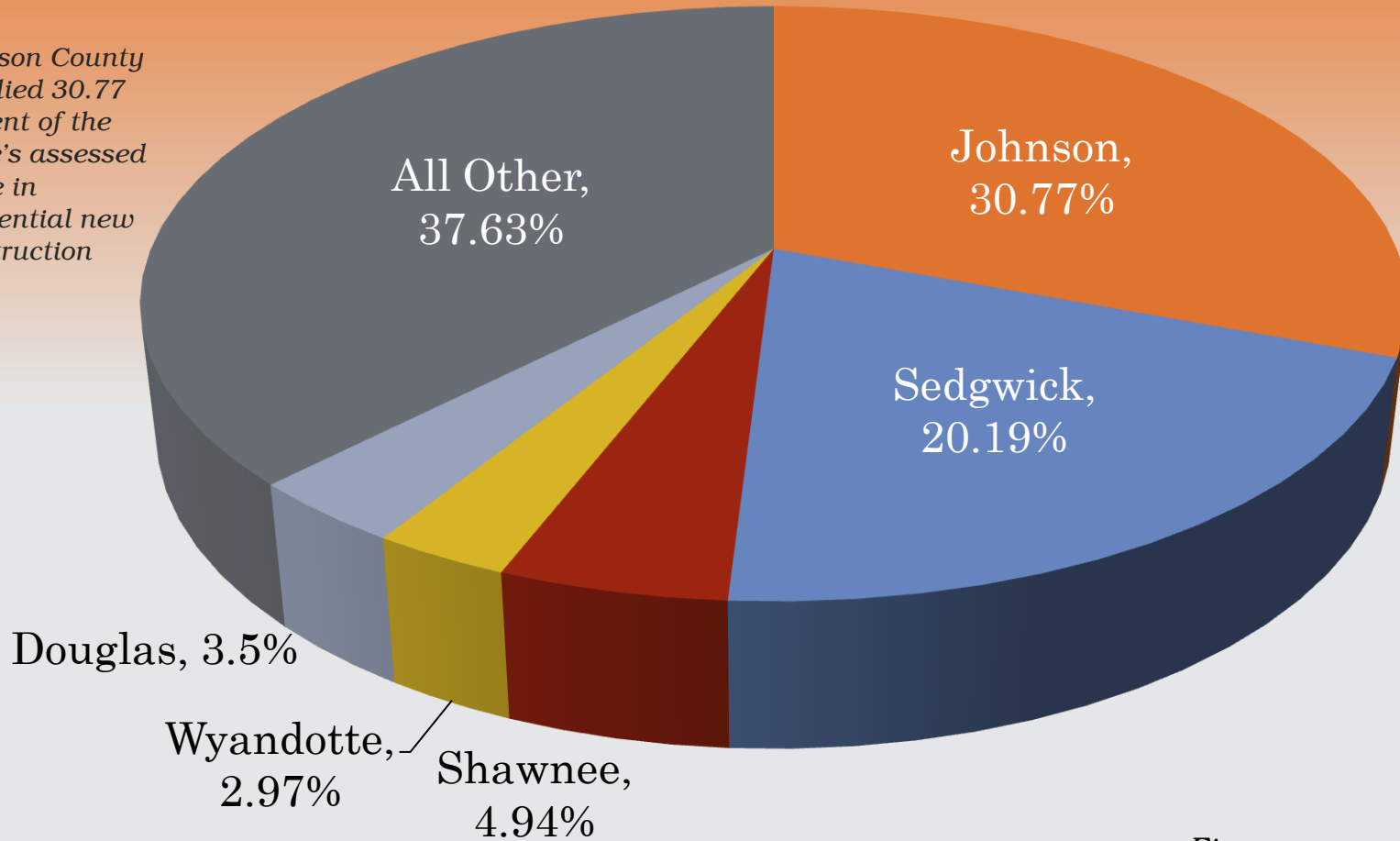

Johnson County supplied 30.77 percent of the State's assessed value in residential new construction

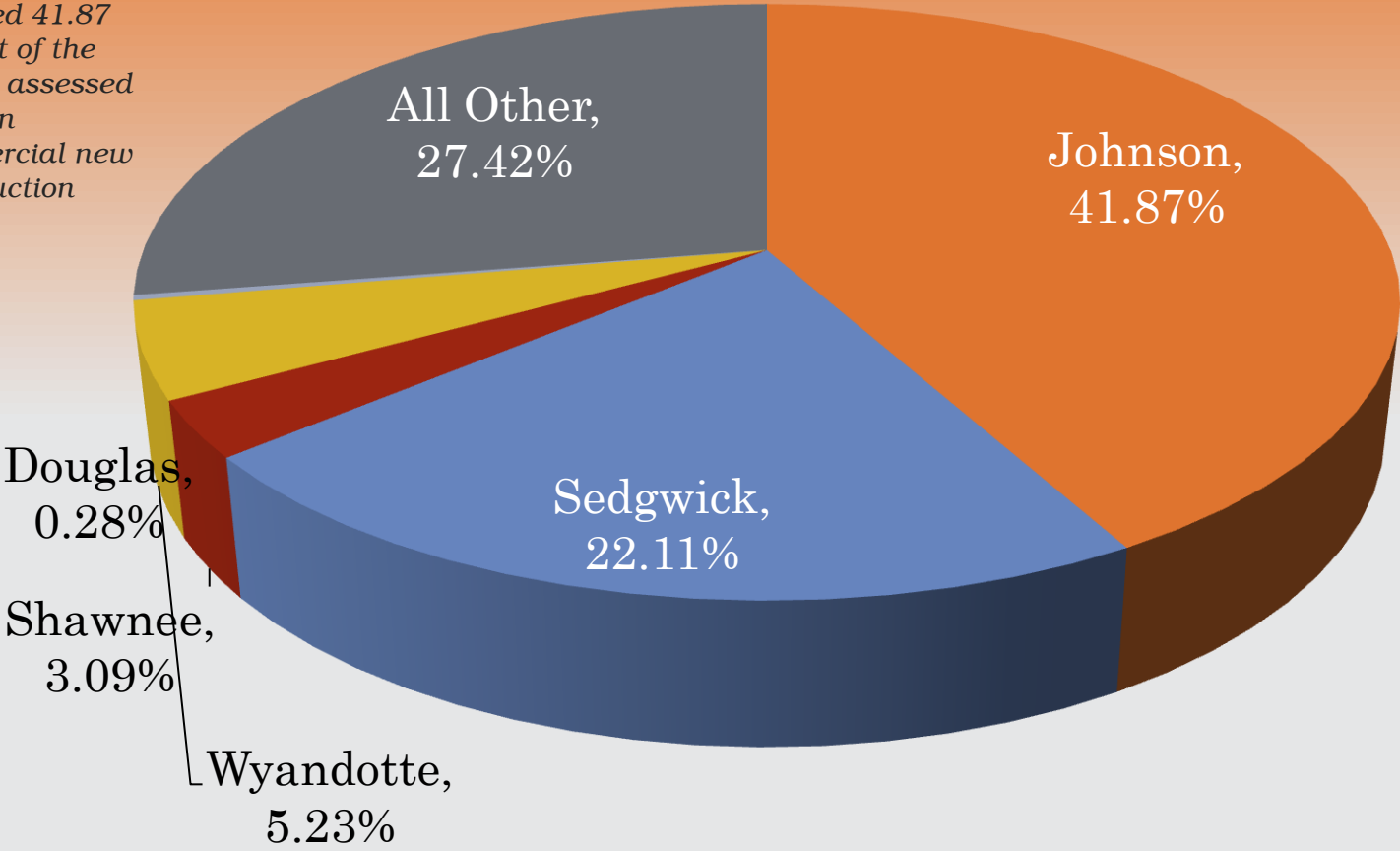
