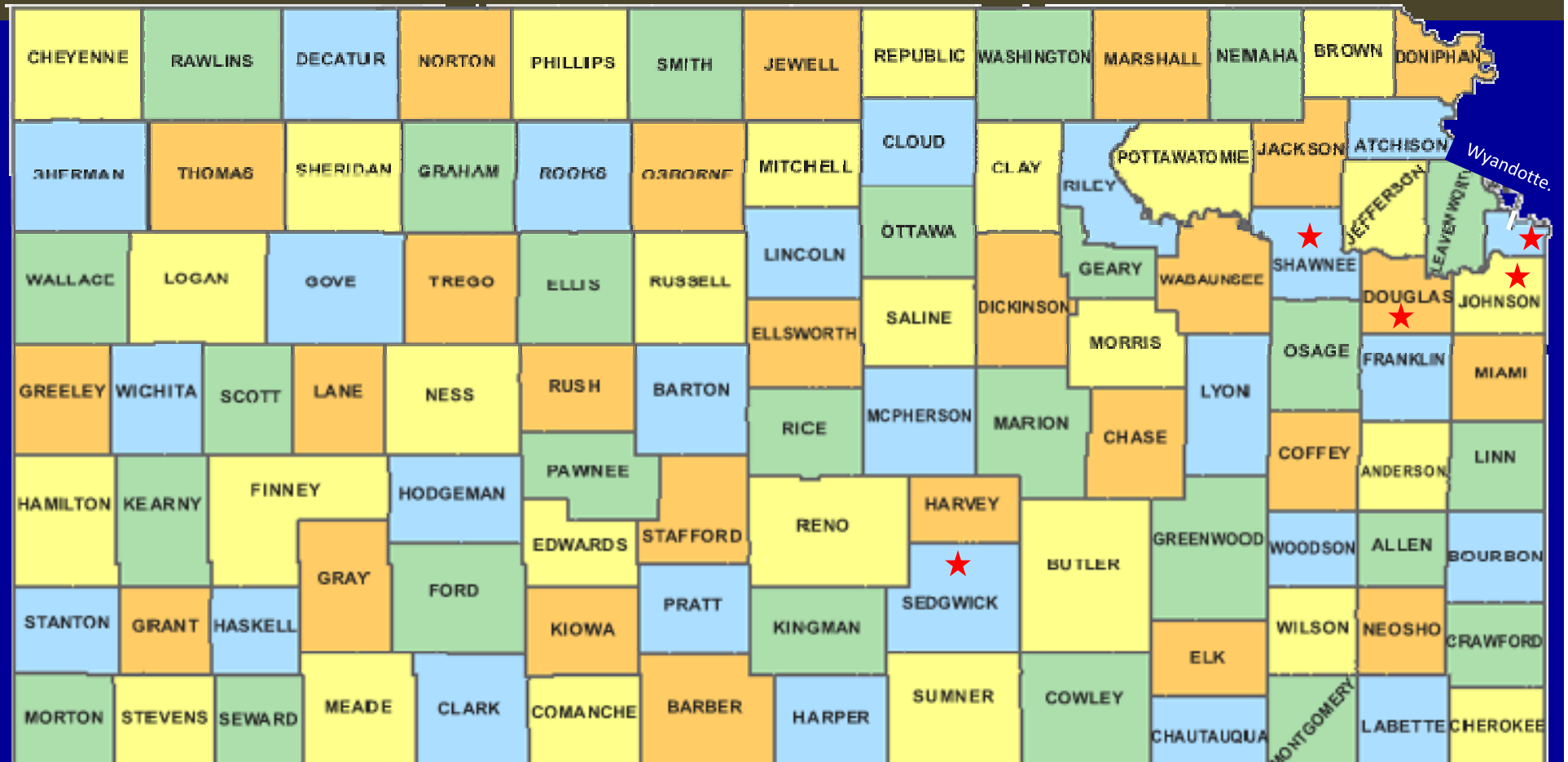

2011 Kansas State Perspective

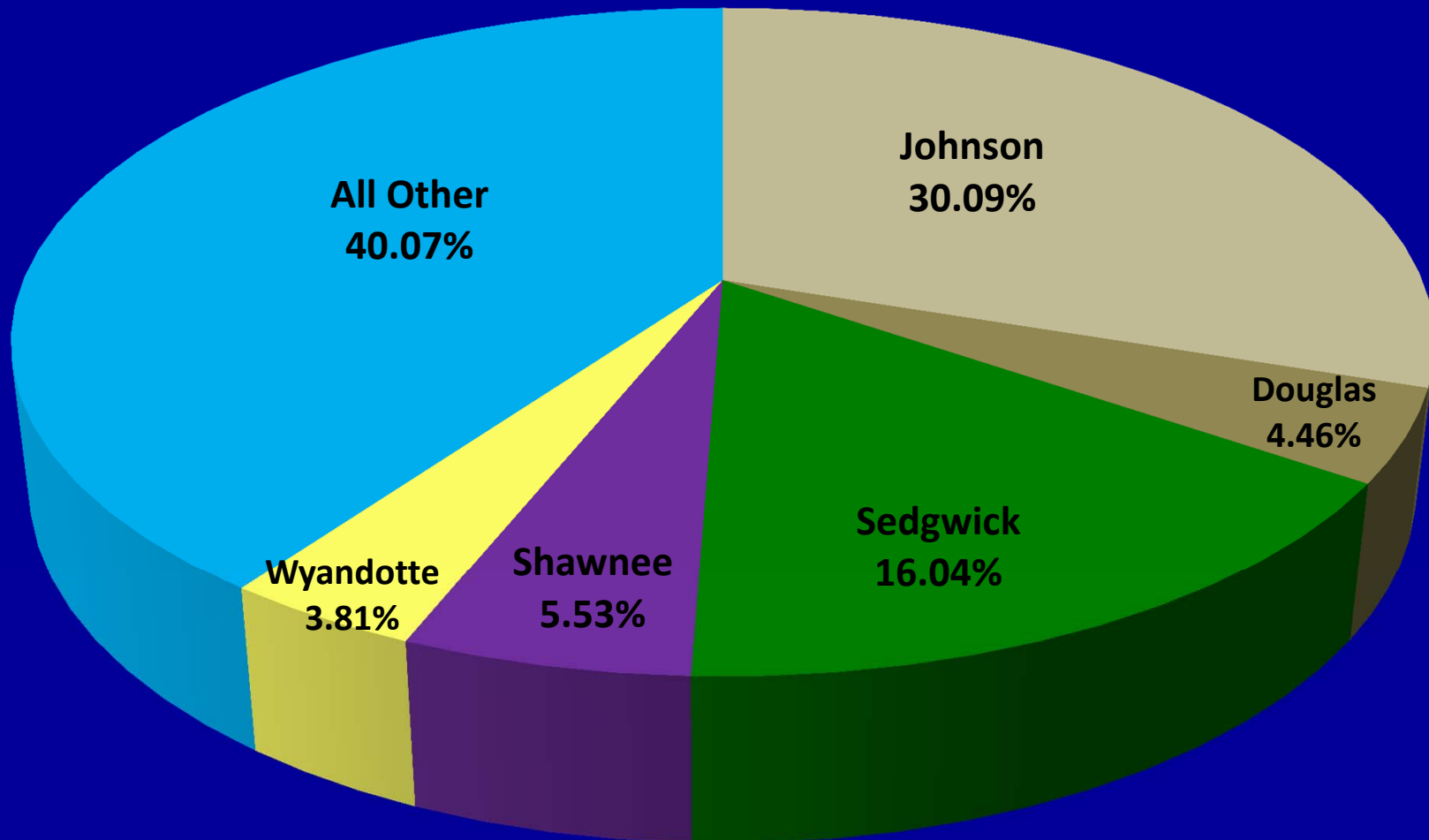
The Kansas Department of Revenue Division of Property Valuation released the 2011 State Perspective in March, 2012. The pie charts shown on the following pages illustrate percentages by county for specific categories and how they compare with the State's total.



2011 Kansas State Perspective

Johnson County contributed 30.09 percent or \$52.4 billion in property valuation to the state's appraised value . This total includes residential, commercial and personal property values.

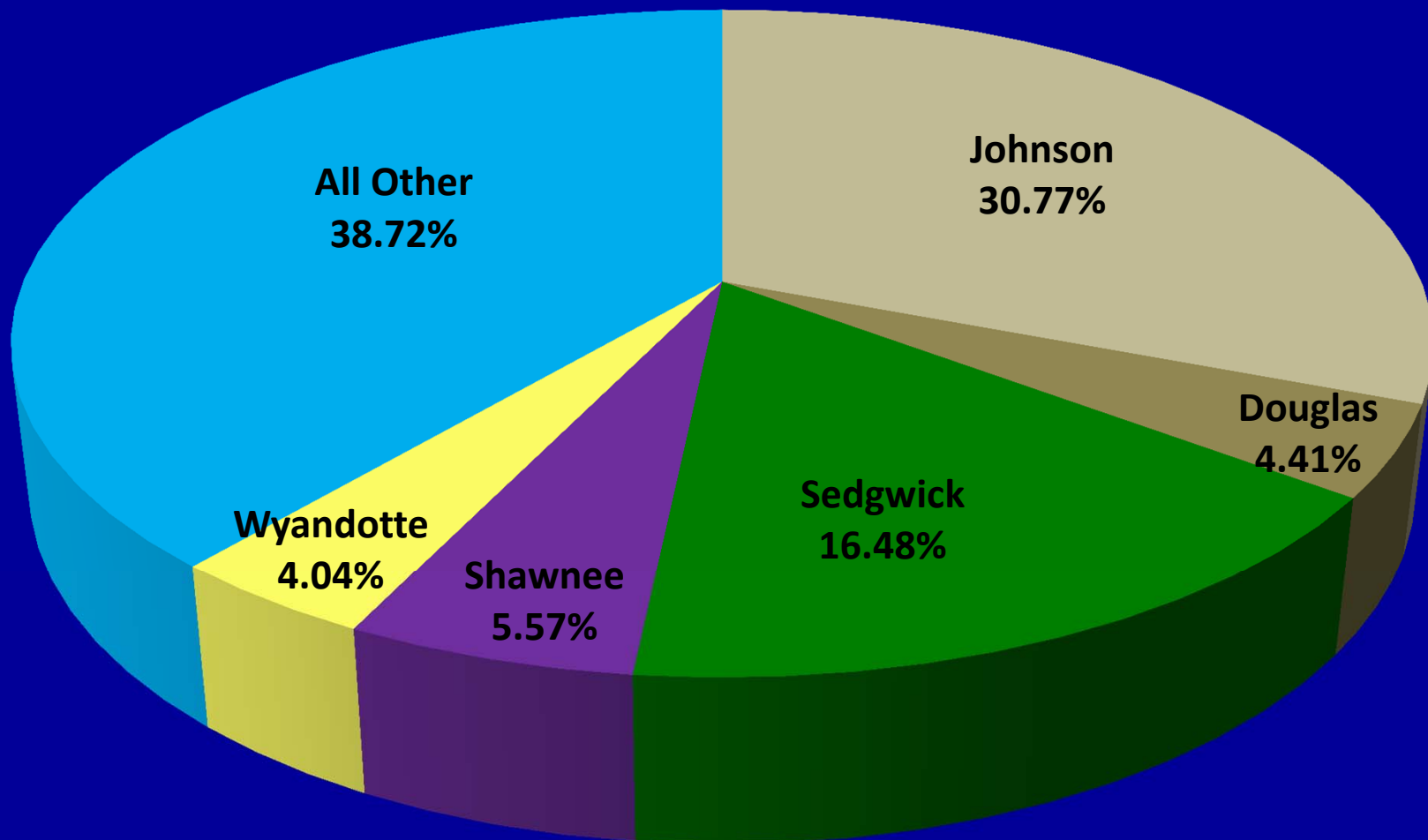
Total All Appraised Property

Johnson County contributed 30.77 percent or \$7.1 billion of the state's assessed real estate value

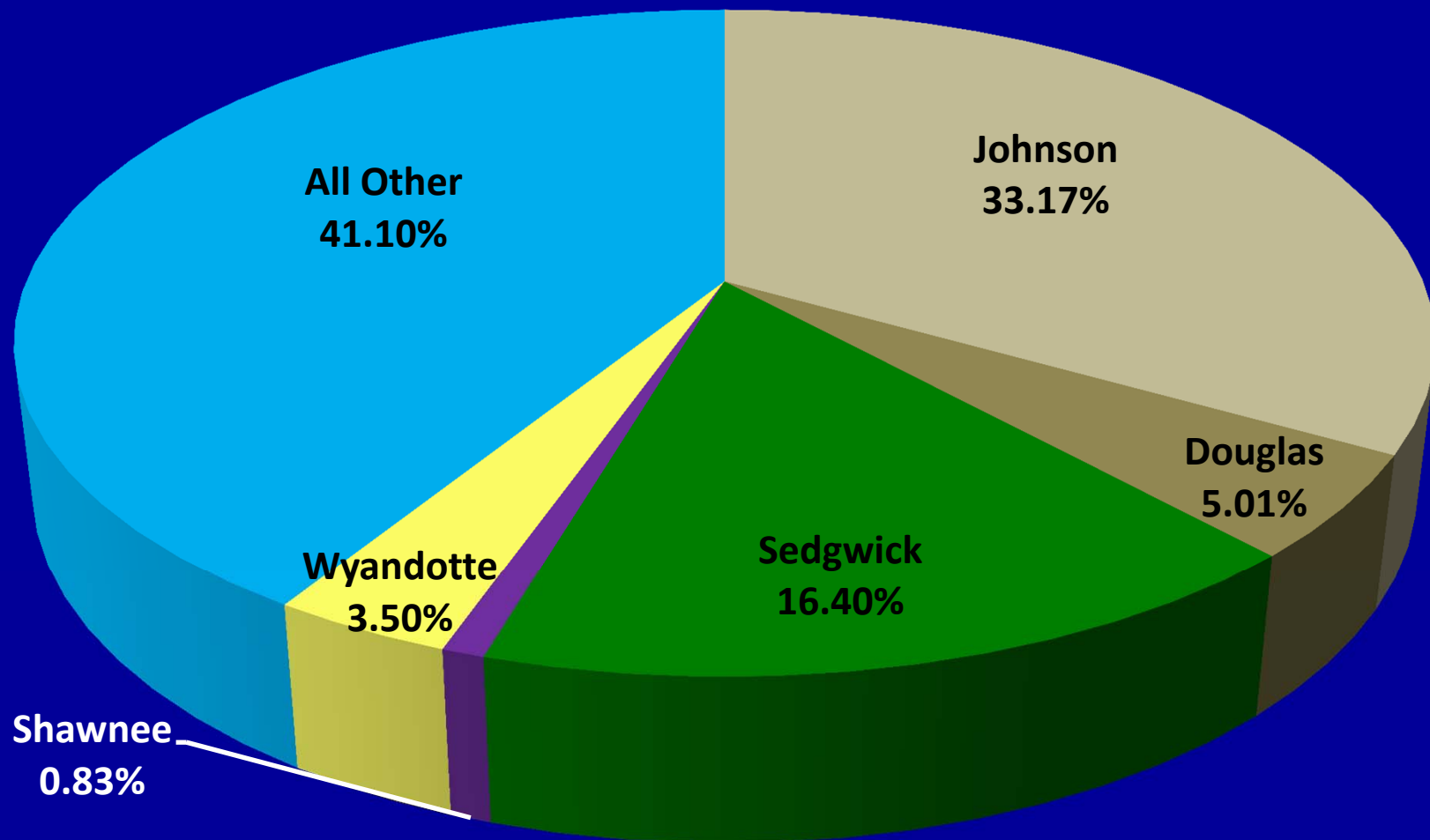
Total Assessed Real Estate

Johnson County contributed 33.17 percent of the state's total assessed value in residential real estate

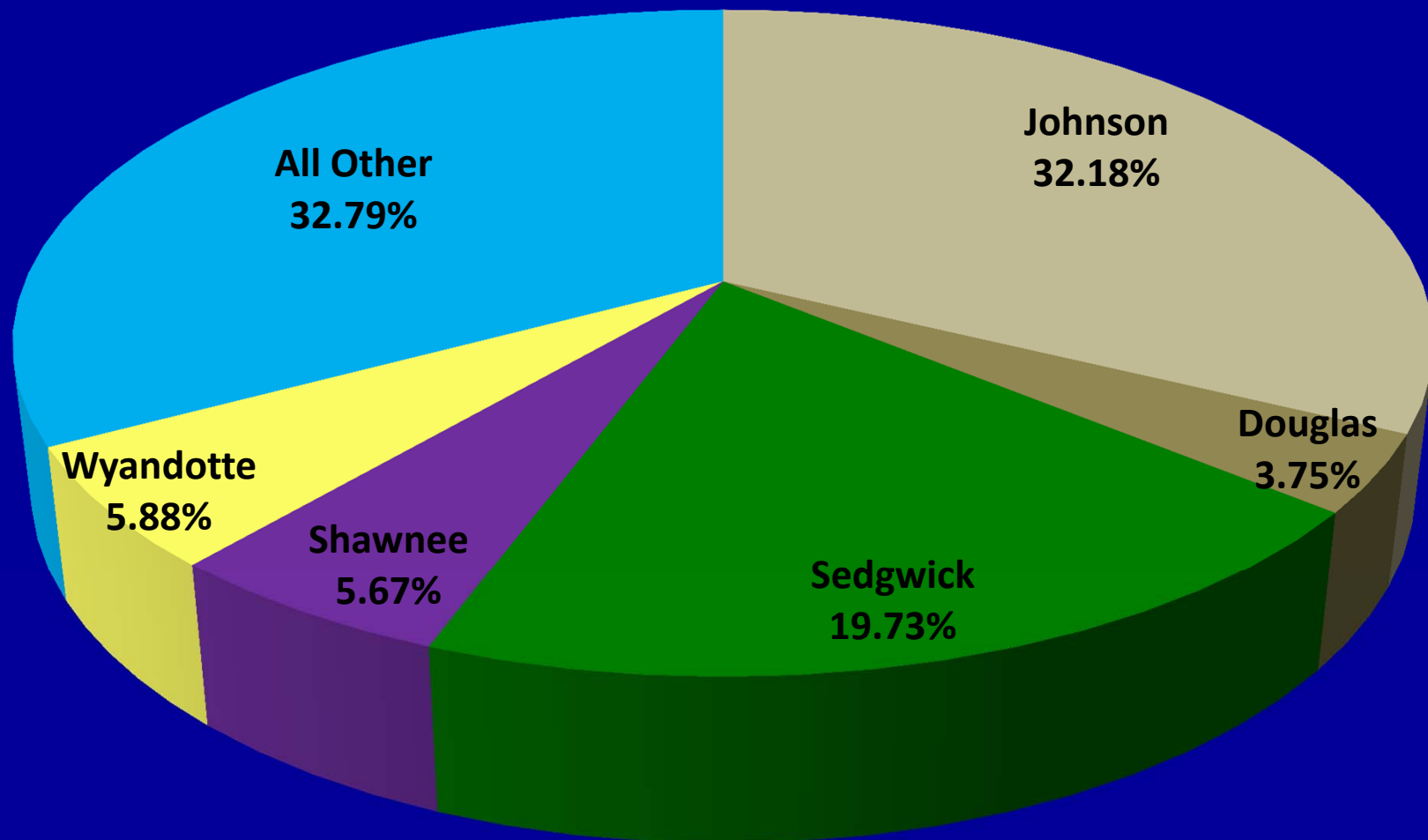
Total Assessed Residential Real Estate

Johnson County contributed 32.18 percent of the state's total assessed value in commercial real estate

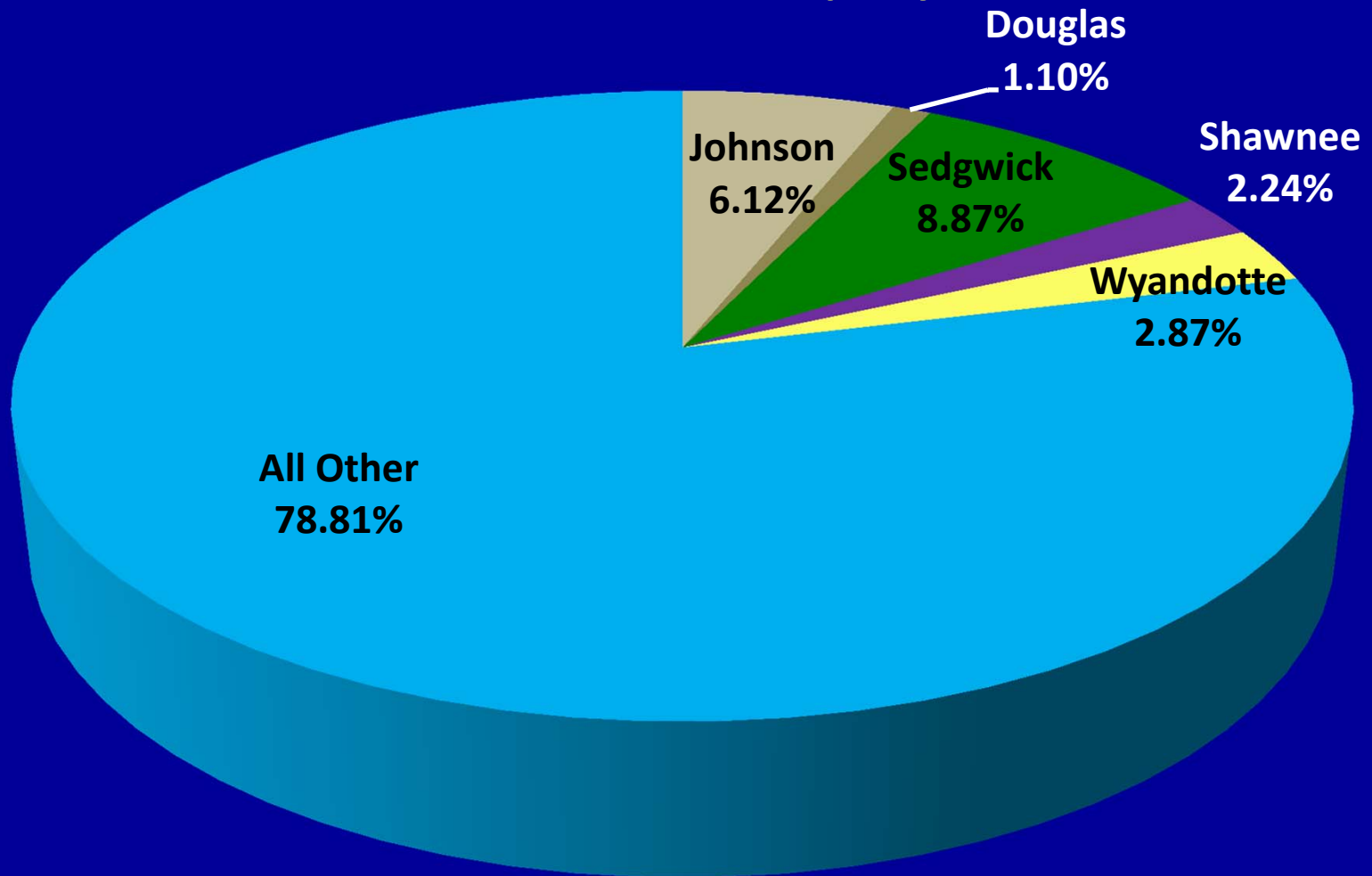
Total Assessed Commercial Real Estate

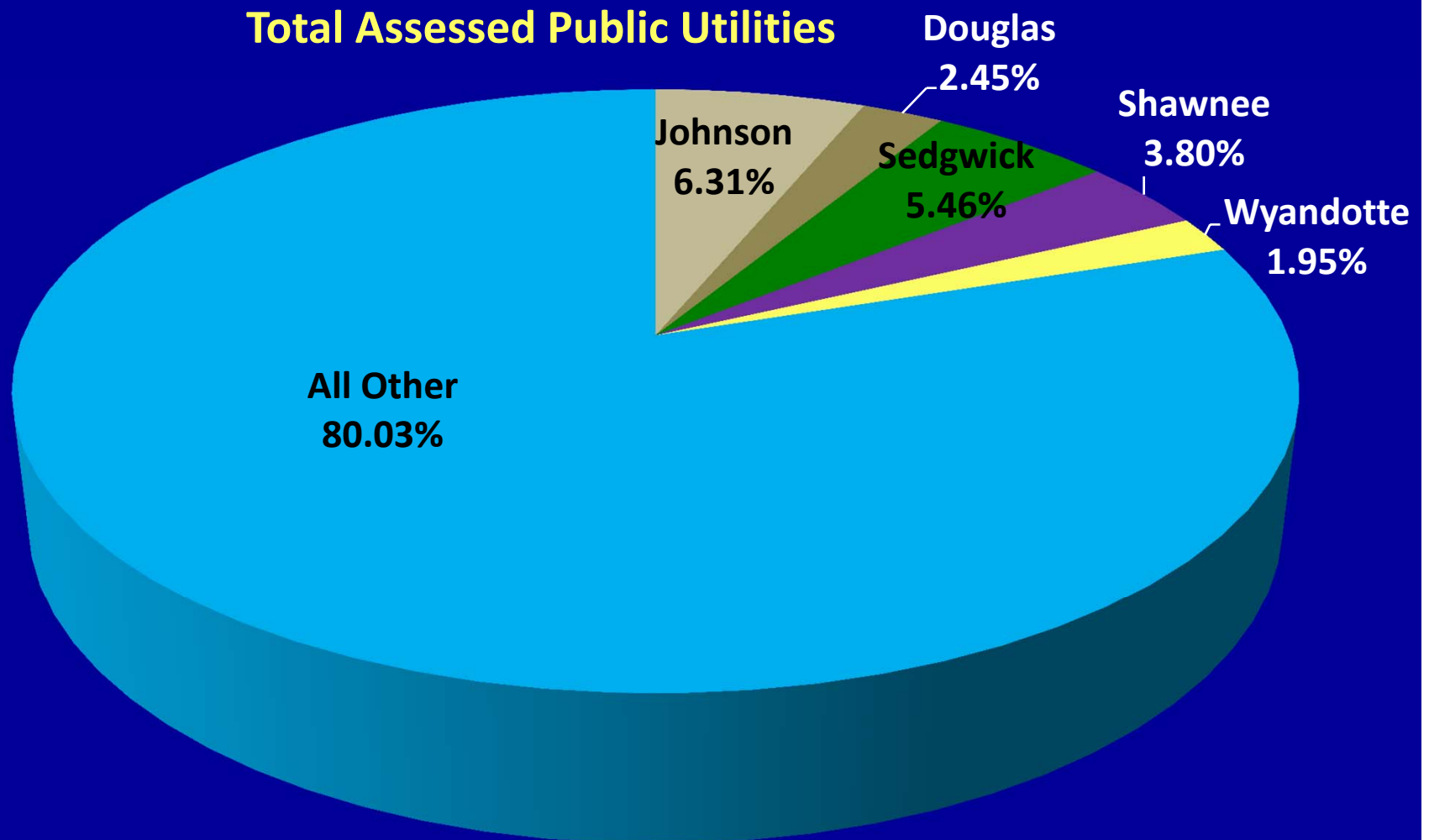
Johnson County contributed 6.12 percent of the state's total assessed value in personal property
