

Definition of Agricultural Building or Structure

“Agricultural Building or Structure”

A building or structure used solely for an agricultural use.

“Agricultural Use”

The use of land, building(s), or structure(s) for the raising of crops; animal husbandry; dairying; pasturage; general farming; cultivation of field crops; orchards; groves; raising fish, birds or poultry, wholesale tree farms, wholesale shrub farms and wholesale plant nurseries; and accessory uses, necessary for the carrying out of farming operations, including structures for storage, processing and sale of products raised on the premises shall not include the following:

1. The operation or maintenance of commercial greenhouses, nurseries or hydroponic farms operated at retail.
2. Wholesale or retail sales as an accessory use unless the same are permitted by these regulations.
