Proposed Amendments to Johnson County's 2016 & 2017 Action Plans

The City of Olathe is requesting that the County consider making the following amendments to the 2016 Action Plan. The proposed rental rehabilitation project has been cancelled, leaving a balance of \$25,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds remaining in the project, and the introduction of Program Income for 2017. Olathe is requesting that the canceled funds be transferred to eligible activities listed in the 2016 Action Plan, including: Olathe Housing Rehabilitation Administration, Olathe Housing Rehabilitation Program, and Olathe Community Enhancement. The Program Income funds will be utilized as a deferred rehabilitation loan fund that enables Olathe to operate a deferred loan program. This activity will provide assistance for the rehabilitation of housing occupied by low and moderate income persons.

These amendments would constitute a substantial amendment to the 2016 & 2017 Action Plans. The County's Citizen Participation Plan calls for a 30-day public comment period before making these amendments.
