

Medication Information

Correct Care Services (CCS) provides medical services for the Johnson County Department of Corrections Adult Residential Center. If you take medication for any health or mental health reason, please read the following information.

With the exception of those medication issued by the Johnson County Detention Center or other Correctional facility we will no longer accept medications brought in with you and/or by family members. CCS will verify all medications and order those that are verified through their medication vendor. If there are any issues during the wait for verification you will be sent to the emergency room to determine the medication needed. Critical medications will be started as soon as possible after admission.

- All medications must immediately be turned in to the Control Center along with all documentation received from your doctor. All medication will be dispensed from the medication dispensing area at the designated times.
- All medications must be taken as prescribed.
- Once you have taken your medicine, be prepared to open your mouth and lift your tongue so staff can see that the medications were taken.
- All medication must be ordered through an approved pharmacy. These would include Diamond Pharmacy for the uninsured and Hy-Vee for the insured. Exceptions would be for those utilizing the VA and/or specialty medications for unusual medical problems.
