### RF with Base

- Light weight radio frequency device
- No GPS, only tracks when client is in or out of range of base.
- Can be used with SL2 RBU.



### SL2 Remote Breath Unit

- Breath Alcohol Testing.
- Photo verification.
- *Can be used in combination with GPS.*
- Utilizes client's cell phone via text when a test needs to be submitted.
- Automated Facial Recognition
- Gives GPS point location where each test is taken.



### Loc8 XT GPS

- Can be used with or without the typical House Arrest restrictive schedule.
- Capability to retroactively investigate client whereabouts at later dates.
- Battery transfer charger that allows for cordless charging.
- Can be used with SL2 RBU



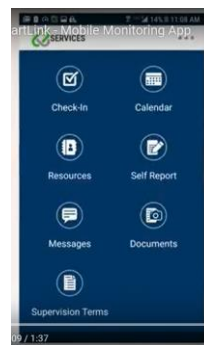
### ReliAlert GPS w/ Secure Cuff

- GPS Tracking
- Steel cuff makes tampering difficult
- Ability to send high frequency alert or call client directly to get Client's attention.
- Reserved for high profile, high risk, certain sex offenders, and those with tampering history.



### TAD Continuous Alcohol Monitor

- Passive Alcohol Monitoring
- Curfew Monitoring/Reporting
- Radio Frequency / not GPS
- Can store 7,000 events/7 days of information



### BI, Inc Smartlink Application

- For Low Risk offenders.
- Biometrically verifies client identity and location through fixed or randomly scheduled check-ins.
- Client must have their own cell phone and a data plan.
- Facial and voice biometric options available.
- Ability for clients and officers to directly message each other. Date and time stamped.

**House Arrest** Adult clients are charged a daily fee and payments are accepted in the form of money orders or credit cards/online payments. Juvenile fees are covered however, clients/parents/guardians may still responsible for loss or damage.

**House Arrest** clients can be subject to random urinalysis and/or breathanalysis testing.

**House Arrest** clients report weekly to meet with their House Arrest Officer, or as directed unless ordered to an "only" program. "Only" programs can still have exclusion areas and must reside at the approved location.

**House Arrest** clients or parents/guardians must have an active cell phone. Clients must have electricity in their residence for completing House Arrest and "only" programs as the equipment has to be charged.

**Juvenile Note:** Once a client has been ordered to the House Arrest Program by a Judge of the District Court, an appointment must be made before a client will be released from JDC. The client will be released 30 minutes prior to the scheduled appointment from JDC to the Parents/ Guardians. The client **MUST** report to the Youth and Family Services Center to be placed on House Arrest immediately following release.
