America Recycles Day Recycling Event in Downtown Overland Park

JOHNSON COUNTY, KAN. (Nov. 12, 2019) – In celebration of America Recycles Day, the Johnson County Department of Health and Environment (JCDHE), Downtown Overland Park, ProShred, and Secure e-Cycle will be hosting an electronics recycling and paper shredding event on Nov. 14 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Patrons can drop off “anything with a cord” to be properly recycled, as well as paper that will be securely shredded. All electronic items are free except TVs (\$25 each) and CRT monitors (\$20 each).

The event will be held in the parking lot near the Overland Park Farmers’ Market pavilion – enter and exit from Marty Street, between 79th and 80th Street. As a courtesy, Johnson County staff and volunteers will be there to unload your vehicle.

“Johnson County is pleased to partner with so many great entities to celebrate America Recycles Day,” said Brandon Hearn, education and outreach coordinator for JCDHE. “One of the world’s fastest growing trash problems is electronic waste. It’s important to recycle it responsibly because so much of it contains hazardous materials.”
