



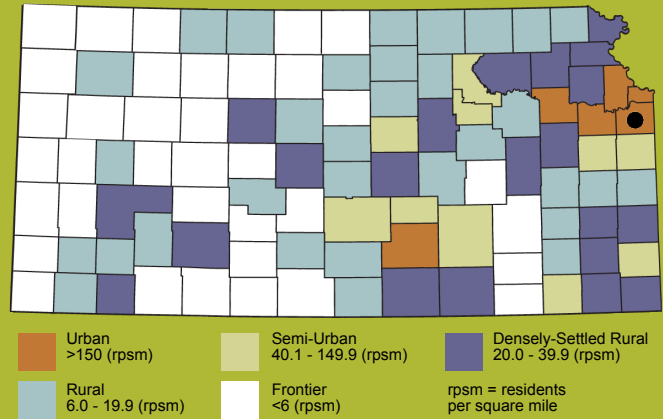

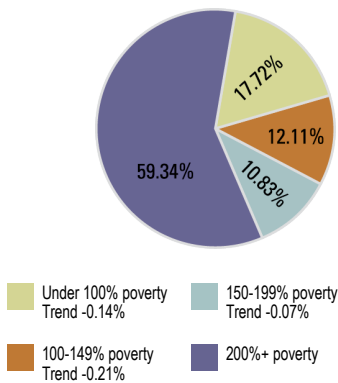

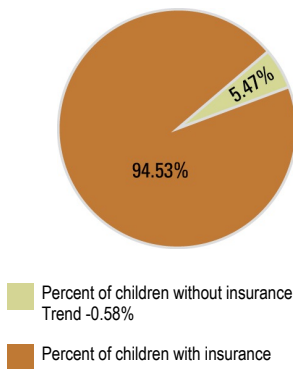
Poverty status of Kansas children under 18.

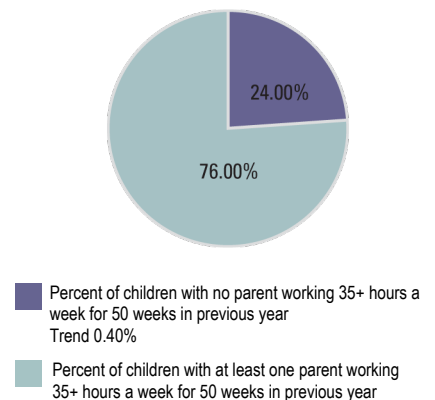
Health insurance status of Kansas children under 18.
