**JCDHE asking health care providers to indicate interest
in getting a COVID-19 vaccine**

(JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS – March 2, 2021) The Johnson County Department of Health & Environment (JCDHE) is asking health care providers who have not yet received their first COVID-19 vaccination to indicate their interest in getting one. This is so JCDHE can assess the number of health care workers still needing vaccine and provide the opportunity for them to receive it.

JCDHE is following the vaccine distribution recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.
