CALL TO ORDER:

The Johnson County Public Art Commission called to order at 5 p.m. by Larry Meeker. Roll was called by Cathy Luckey.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mary Tearney made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 28, 2016 meeting. Christopher Leitch seconded the motion and all approved.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Master Plan – General discussion regarding a procedural amendment in regards to the criteria the PAC offers to the ASP for review of submissions to assure we are reviewing the broadest selection of candidates in an effort to expand our collection. Discussed ways to word the call for Artists to include new artists not already represented in the County Collection.

Discussed ideas for the new Courthouse art; incorporating the approval into the general project with the other small items and not go back to the BOCC for approval after the ASP makes their recommendations. Also ideas of incorporating the Art into the structure or design of the building, and the greenspace vacated by the old courthouse being considered for location of art for the Courthouse.

Brad Goldberg's formal proposal to the BOCC/PBC is scheduled for December 1. On December 6th, the BOCC will have their final vote. Discussed the idea of inviting as many ASP members and general public to the December 1st meeting as possible and advertising it as an opportunity for Brunch with the Artists in the Cafeteria during the business session of the meeting before the presentation.

Mary Tearney made a motion for Formal Approval of Brad Goldberg's proposal for A&HC and recommendation to the BOCC/PBC. Amy Wright seconded the motion, all approved.

Christopher gave us an update on the Monticello Library – 2 finalist artists are fully developing their proposals with guidance of Chad and Georgia. Beth has met with the project team for siting the work in relation to the pathway. Woodfill & Lichty scheduled series of conversations with everyone involved with this project to get a sense of the social understanding of the life of the space.
