Indian Creek Interceptor 2 Capacity Improvements Project**

Johnson County Wastewater (JCW) invites you to participate in the third of three public meetings to discuss sanitary sewer capacity improvements in your neighborhood (the area in Prairie Village and Overland Park bound approximately by W. 90th Terrace to the North, Indian Creek to the South, Roe Avenue to the East, and Nall Avenue/Outlook Drive to the West). The public meeting will be held on **Thursday, November 9, at 7:00 pm, at the Christ Church Anglican (Room Disciples Center), 5500 W. 91st Street** (see map on back).

Representatives of JCW, their engineering consultant, and the contractor building the improvements will be present at this meeting to discuss different facets of the project. Residents will have the opportunity to meet the project team, ask questions, and learn more about this construction project which will increase capacity of the existing public sanitary sewers. The construction schedule and construction-related impacts will be discussed at this meeting.
