

Using the Johnson County AIMS Mapping System

- Please review the data disclaimer and the Kansas Open Records Act policy and select the “Continue” button.
- A Security Warning will display regarding redirection to another site. Select “Yes” to continue.
- The AIMS “Online Mapping” webpage will then display.
- The “Layers” menu bar is on the left. This menu bar controls the features that are displayed in the map window. Some of these features are too detailed to be shown on the large scale maps, but will display at reduced scales.
- The map window initially displays the entire County.
- The map window can be controlled with the zoom bar and pan button in the upper left corner of the map.
- Tools to manipulate the map and to provide specific information on map attributes are available in the menu along the top of the map window.
- To begin, enter a specific address or street intersection in the “Search For Location” box above the map window
- Select “Search Map” to locate the site of interest.
- Manipulate the map location as required to get the desired view using the zoom and pan tools.
- To display the Johnson County Wastewater sanitary sewer system, select “Utilities” in the “Layers” directory on the left side menu.
- Then select the “JCW Sewer Lines” box. The sanitary sewers and manholes are displayed automatically as green lines and dots in the map window.
- To open the As-built record for an existing sewer main, select the “Identify Features” button (the blue dot with the “i” in it) in the tool bar above the map window.
- Next, select the green sewer line of interest on the map. An “Identify Results” popup window will be displayed.
- Please select “Yes” if your computer security settings or a “Popup” blocker requests you to allow this webpage.
- Select the “As-builts” number in the “Identify Results” window to open the applicable plan sheet(s).
