## Pay-as-you-throw:

Every hauler shall have a volume based rate structure which establishes a base volume and charge for the customer's regular collection cycle. This basic solid waste collection service shall have a maximum weekly volume that shall not exceed the equivalent of a 95/96 gallon container. For a full description of the Volume Based Rate Structure requirements please see Article 4, Section 5 of the Johnson County Solid Waste Code or call 913-238-6880.

Each licensed hauler must provide a tonnage report indicating all waste collected from Johnson County residents from January 1 through December 31, of the preceding year. **Report includes:**

1. Landfill waste
2. Recyclables
3. Yard waste

**Records are required to be submitted by January 31, 2017.**
