

CHAMPSS CARDS HAVE A NEW LOOK!

We have updated our technology at the stores. Stores will be able to take a picture of your card instead of swiping it.

Even though your card is new, your CHAMPSS number has stayed the same.

CHAMPSS is a nutrition program.

We follow strict federal nutrition guidelines. We work closely with the Hy-Vee dietitians who have identified the meal options in the store that meet our requirements. If a meal item is not part of the CHAMPSS meal plan it is because it does not meet these guidelines. Please do not put the Hy-Vee staff in an awkward position by asking for non-approved options.

All CHAMPSS sessions will be online until further notice due to Covid-19.

Do not hit the back-arrow button on your web browser to restart the process. Then, when you proceed to the checkout, if your credit card does not work, you might have inadvertently saved your credit card information to your web browser. Go to the browser's advance settings to see if this is the issue.
